

SETUP FOR HIDE MENU OPTION

Step 1

Go into the users home directory and insert in their `.bash_profile` the following:

```
SLVL=2; export SLVL
```

Then go into the root user home directory and insert the following in the `.bash_profile`

```
SLVL=99; export SLVL
```

If you would like to add this feature for every new user added you can insert

```
SLVL=2; export SLVL
```

into the `.bash_profile` in `/etc/skel` directory , so that it will add it to every new user created automatically.

Step 2

The next step is to login as root and then change the directory to the users home directory. Example : `cd /home/bryan` Once you have done that then type in `strategy5` and go to the main menu and hit Shift F2 and the following menu will pop up:

If you want to hide a menu from a user put a "3" in the SL column and then in the H column put a "Y" and you will do that for every menu you wish to hide. When you are done hit F9 to save and then when the user logs in they will only see the menus that are not set to hide. You will do this for every user that you want to hide menus from.

If you want to hide the same menu with several users, then you only need to do it once and then you can copy the file to another users home directory.

```
Example: [root@strategy bryan]# cp menu.cfg ../tim
```

This would be all you would have to do to duplicate the same menu options for a different user.
